Where do I make my court payment?

Payments for fines, fees, and restitution can be mailed or delivered to:

You will be required to pay a \$30 one-time fee when you report for community service work.

What do I do if my address changes?

How much and how do I pay for SOMS to monitor my bench probation?

SOMS orientation/enrollment fee is \$30 (one-time), payable by cash, money order, or cashier's check at the initial meeting. You will be required to pay \$25 to SOMS monthly, beginning the date of your court order. If you have questions, call us! You can mail in your payment or bring it by the office.

SOMS Fee Policy

1. You are required to pay \$30 for the enrollment fee and \$25 per month for monitoring fees. You are only required to pay monitoring fees until you have completed the bench probation conditions.

Those conditions of bench probation include:

- ◆ Community Service Work
- ◆ Substance Abuse Evaluation and Treatment
- ◆ _____

2. If SOMS is required to prepare documents for District Attorney action on your case, you will be required to pay the following fees:

- ◆ Return to Court *Including court appearances* \$100
- ◆ Other Misc Documents.....\$25

3. SOMS will continue to monitor your case until your bench probation ends. If you still owe for court fines and fees, you can continue making payments to the court.

4. If you have questions, please call or email us.


It is our goal that you complete these conditions as rapidly as possible. Once completed, you no longer are required to pay monitoring fees. If you have completed all of the conditions of your bench probation but not paid off your court fines, you are not required to pay SOMS fees.
